## F. VARIANCE REQUEST: 202-15-001A: CARPENTER: ALLOWING EXISTING SHED TO REMAIN IN THE FRONT YARD AND BEFORE THE PRIMARY STRUCTURE WAS CONSTRUCTED

Nathan Carpenter presented the item; planning and zoning recommended a lot line change so that the shed would not be in the front of the yard. Would like the variance to keep the lot lines how they are and also be allowed to keep the shop in the front of the primary structure.
