A. VARIANCE REQUEST: 202-41-072: GARY & BETTY GRAHAM: REQUESTING APPROVAL FOR KEEPING A CARPORT IN THE FRONT YARD THAT ENCROACHES ON THE SETBACK

Mr. Graham presented his request to the council. It was recommended for approval by the planning and zoning commission. They have letters from 8 neighbors that are in favor of keeping the carport as it is, even though it encroaches on the setback.

C. ZONING CHANGE REQUEST: 202-38-008B: BURK: REZONE FROM R-1 TO AG
