Bigtooth Maple	Acer grandidentatum	40 ft	25 ft.	Full / Part	Moderate	Slow to moderate growth.Prune when young to single trunk.Needs well-drained soil on the dry side.Fall colors rose red,orange,yellow.
Boxelder	Acer negundo	45 ft.	30 ft.	Full / Part	Frequent	Fast growth.Train to ensure good form.`Sensation' is seedless,has more controlled growth,red fall color.Other varieties yellow in fall.
European White Birch	Betula pendulata	40 ft.	30 ft.	Full / Part	Frequent	Moderate growth.Needs wind protection. Often sold as weeping birch. Cultivar`Crispi' is common,cold hardy & strongly weeping
Himalayan Birch	Betula utilis ( var. jaquemontii )	45 ft	25 ft.	Full / Part	Frequent	Moderate growth.Bark varies from glossy orange-brown or dark copper-brown to pure white.Gold-yellow fall color.Buy grafted trees.
Catalpa	Catalpa speciosa	40 ft.	30 ft.	Full / Part	Moderate	Large ovate leaves 12"L.x8"W. Seeds 18"L. brown capsule.White trumpet-shaped flowers early summer.Hardy,needs wind protection.
English Hawthorn	Crataegus laevigata ( C. oxyacantha )	25 ft.	15 ft.	Full	Moderate	Slow-moderate growth. Varieties with white, pink or scarlet flowers with summer into fall small red berry-like fruit. Great tree for wildlife.
Green Ash, Red Ash	Fraxinus pennsylvanica	40 ft.	30 ft.	Full / Part	Moderate	Moderate-fast growth.Tolerant of cold & drought when established. Best varieties,`Patmore',`Marshall' & `Summit' are seedless.
Honey Locust (thornless)	Gleditsia triacanthos ( var. inermis )	60 ft.	40 ft.	Full	Moderate	Fast growth.Tolerates compacted soil,heat,wind,some drought. Varieties:`Shademaster',`Sunburst' are thornless-podless;`Imperial'.

Golden Rain Tree	Koelreuteria paniculata	30 ft.	30 ft.	Full	Moderate	Slow to moderate growth. Takes heat, cold, wind & little water when established. Summer yellow flowers in 18" long clusters. Fall color.
Crabapple	Malus sp.	30 ft.	20 ft.	Full	Moderate	Moderate growth. Very hardy ,spring flowering( white,pink,red ); small fruit. Good varieties: `Prairiefire', `Spring Snow', & `Profusion'.
White Mulberry	Morus alba	50 ft.	50 ft.	Full / Part	Moderate	Moderate-fast growth.Fruitless varieties best.Will produce pollen & surface roots.Good shade,takes heat.Stake & prune first 2-3 yrs.
London Plane	Platanus x acerifolia	60 ft.	40 ft.	Full	Moderate	Fast growth.Maple like leaves 5-10" in L. & W.,fruit 1"bristly brown balls,on long stalks.Often sold as P. orientalis.
Lance Leaf Cottonwood	Populus acuminata	60 ft.	25 ft.	Full	Frequent	Fast growth.Sharply pointed egg-shaped leaves to 4" L.Very hardy & wind tollerent.Yellow fall color.Root invasive near water & sewer.
White Poplar	Populus alba	80 ft.	40 ft.	Full / Part	Moderate	Fast growth.`Pyramidalis' & `Bolleana' are pyramidal/columnar forms.Leaves green on top,white & hairy beneath.Suckers profusely
Narrow Leaf Cottonwood	Populus angustifolia	60 ft.	30 ft.	Full	Frequent	Fast growth.Leaves 5"L.x1.5"W.Cold hardy.Roots are invasive to underground pipes.As with all cottonwoods, male clones are best.
